## SCHOLARSHIP ELIGIBILITY

- Be a North Carolina resident for tuition purposes
- Reside in a qualifying rural North Carolina county
- Be a graduating North Carolina high school senior or a currently enrolled North Carolina community college transfer student enrolling full-time in the fall
- Have a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.5
- Plan to enroll in a participating North Carolina public or private college/university
- Have a Free application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) Student Aid Index (SAI) that does not exceed the maximum permitted by Golden LEAF
- Be able to communicate a commitment to returning to a rural North Carolina county after graduation from college

## SCHOLARSHIP AMOUNT

- High school seniors entering college as first-year students are eligible for up to a \$14,000 scholarship (\$3,500 a year for up to four years).
- Community college transfer students are eligible for up to a \$10,500 scholarship (\$3,500 a year for up to three years).

## APPLICATION DEADLINE

All application materials (application, FAFSA, transcript) must be submitted by **March 1st, 2024**.

## GOLDEN LEAF SCHOLARSHIP OPPORTUNITIES

Students awarded the Golden LEAF Scholarship are also eligible to participate in additional development and internship opportunities. These engagements allow scholars to gain experience in their future career fields and build key communication and leadership skills.

### Rural Internship Initiative

Golden LEAF offers a paid internship opportunity for students to gain experience at an eligible business, non-profit, or government entity located in a rural North Carolina community.
