## Scholarship Application

<u>Purpose:</u> The purpose of the *NCACTE Guidance and Career Development Division Scholarship* is to assist the recipient during his/her higher education by subsidizing the cost of attending a community college or university. The Scholarship is available on a competitive basis to graduating high school students who have taken Career and Technical Education courses and achieved the status of a CTE completer.

**Award:** \$4,000 (To be distributed by semester over a 2 year period.)

#### **Eligibility:**

- Applicants must be a high school senior with a CTE concentration.
- Applicants must be enrolled or accepted to an accredited four (4) year College or university, community college or technical school for the Fall of 2015.
- Applicants must possess a minimum grade point average of 3.0 on a 4.0 scale.
- Applicants must enroll with a CTE related major.

#### Application Period – May 1, 2015 – May 25, 2015

#### **Selection**

A <u>Review Committee</u> will select the scholarship recipient. Applicants will be evaluated on the following criteria:

- Academic Achievement in both Core and CTE courses
- Demonstrated desire to pursue a CTE career
- Letters of recommendation that demonstrate the student's character
- Pursuit of a full-time student status at a four (4) year university or a (2) year community or technical college
- A type-written personal statement that communicates the student's academic and career interests, and personal goals
- A brief statement of financial need and how the scholarship will assist the student in making the transition from high school to college.
