

SCHOLARSHIP OPPORTUNITY

The Kathleen Morrissey Klutey Memorial Scholarship Fund

Students who fit the following eligibility criteria are encouraged to apply for this scholarship from the North Carolina Community Foundation.

CRITERIA

Current seniors at a Lenoir County public high school who intend to enroll in a four-year college or university. Recipients will be chosen on the basis of having demonstrated exceptional academic performance while taking a rigorous course load, as well as having significant involvement in extracurricular activities (e.g. athletics or the arts). Financial need is not required, but may be considered. PLEASE NOTE: Essay should highlight how the student has taken advantage of the school's Advanced Placement and other advanced course offerings, and should also detail the student's demonstrated achievement and leadership experience in his/her primary extracurricular pursuits.

DEADLINE

Applications for this scholarship are due by **March 15**.

Scholarship awards are made in the late spring or early summer; scholarship payments are made directly to the student's college or university.
