The Light on the Hill Society Scholarship effort began during the 2005 UNC Black Alumni Reunion. Organizers challenged alumni to initially contribute \$1,952 each – representing the 1952 class year of Harvey Beech, Carolina's first African-American graduate – to become founding members of the scholarship fund.

For the more than 13 years, Carolina alumni and friends have annually made tax-deductible gifts to the fund, ranging from a few dollars to several thousand, the largest being a \$350,000 gift from NFL star Julius Peppers '02.

The Light on the Hill Society Scholarship will award ten (10) scholarships to African-American students who will enroll at UNC Chapel Hill for fall 2019.

- Two (2) \$2,000 Julius Peppers scholarships, renewable up to three years
- Eight (8) \$2,500 LOTH scholarships, one-time awards
- The application deadline is 11:59 p.m. (EST) on Sunday, March 3, 2019.

By providing scholarships to first-year African-American students, this award serves as a tribute to African-American alumni of the 1950s and 1960s who were instrumental in the desegregation of UNC Chapel Hill.

A selection committee will evaluate applicants based on the following:

- Academic achievement
- Evidence of community service
- Leadership qualities
- Strength of essays
