- Must have a Cumulative GPA of 2.5 or better (on a 4.0 scale)
- Must submit a current official high school transcript (Traditional or Electronic) with an authorized official's signature

- Must submit the essay section of the application, with headings for each of the five sections of the essay
- Must submit a completely executed and signed Beta Kappa Sigma Chapter Scholarship application (original or electronic signature acceptable)

- All copies of transcripts must be the official, original documents, issued by the high school
- Once you have received a Beta Kappa Sigma Chapter award, any instance of criminal activities will disqualify you from any future, additional, or continuing awards.
