3 Simple steps to apply for Pitt Community College Scholarships:

- 1. Apply for admission to Pitt Community College and receive notification of admission.
- 2. Apply for FAFSA. (A current year FAFSA should be on file with PCC)
- 3. Apply for a PCC Scholarship.

Requirements for PCC Scholarship application to be reviewed:

- 1. Read and <u>THOROUGHLY</u> complete the application. If any information is not completed, the application will be considered incomplete and <u>will NOT</u> be reviewed.
- 2. Students <u>must</u> have a <u>2.5 minimum cumulative GPA</u> to apply. A high school transcript <u>must</u> be attached to verify GPA.
- 3. Students **must** be eligible for in-state tuition.
- 4. Return the completed application to the Office of Institutional Advancement, Vernon White Building, Room 16. Applications must be received <u>in</u> the Institutional Advancement Office <u>NO LATER THAN WEDNESDAY</u>, <u>MARCH 15th at 4:00 p.m.</u>
